QUALIFICATIONS

To work on deck, all positions require sea survival and medicals as a bare minimum. First Aid and Firefighting training is also required in addition to basic certificates.

ROV Pilots:

An Electronics Degree is preferable Plus the offshore certs to allow them to work on vessels.

Skippers:

MCA recognised qualification to allow them to skipper commercial work boats.

SKILLS

Some of the additional skills you might need to work for this company include:

ROV Pilot's requires a full knowledge of electronics and mechanics, as well as the skill to pilot the ROV.

MD requires all the above skills plus the ability to manage the vessel's maintenance regime, crew safety certificates, full knowledge of HSE for the industry. Risk assessments are carried out for every job, and must also be able to talk to clients about their needs and pricing.

OPPORTUNITIES

On the job training is available, as they regularly take on Deckhands who can be trained up to Skipper, either by them or a stepping stone to other marine operators.
