They operate airports which meet regulatory standards and support essential transport connectivity. They are also responsible for maintaining and developing airport infrastructure and services, working with airlines and others to maintain and develop scheduled, charter and freight air services while also developing their commercial revenue to build business resilience.

In Orkney they are based just outside Kirkwall, but they also operate at Barra, Benbecula, Campbeltown, Dundee, Inverness, Islay, Stornoway, Sumburgh, Tiree and Wick John O'Groats Airports. They employ over 600 members of staff across their network.
