

ABOUT ORKNEY SHELLFISH HATCHERY

The Orkney Shellfish Hatchery breeds European Flat Oysters (Ostrea Edulis) which are sold primarily to restoration projects helping to improve our marine environment by increasing stocks of local shellfish around the coast of Scotland and Europe. Staff are at the hatchery every day of the year - including Christmas! - to ensure that the oysters are well looked after, giving them the best quality food and keeping them clean. Microalgae is also grown onsite to feed the oysters and they also culture Lobsters and their food.

The company is based on Lambholm and they also have three aquaculture sister-companies (all owned by Cadman Capital): The Oyster Restoration Company in West Scotland, Ocean On Land Technology and Caribbean Sustainable Fisheries. Locally, they employ eight people but also have staff off-site that work with them and their our sister companies.
