The team are based in the council offices at School Place in Kirkwall.

WHAT SUPPORT IS AVAILABLE

Most of the support offered is person centred, one-to-one work, however occasionally the team work with small groups with similar interests.

The support available can include:

Develop skills and confidence. Find training courses to help you get a job. Finding work placements to get experience. Support with writing CVs and preparing for interviews. Help to find a job which matches an individual's skills and needs. On the job support so individuals can learn how to do work tasks. Regular meetings with individual and their employer to make sure the job is going well.

Support to develop your career.

WHO CAN ACCESS SUPPORT

The Learning Disability Employment Support team support:

People who are aged 16 years of age or older. People with learning disabilities. People with Autistic Spectrum Disorders. Some people who struggle to understand information, learn skills and cope independently.
