ABOUT NHS ORKNEY

NHS Orkney are the smallest territorial health board in Scotland and are responsible for the health care of the population of Orkney, which is made up of approximately 21,500 people. They provide a comprehensive range of primary, community-based and acute hospital services.

Staff are based across the Orkney mainland and isles, with the Balfour Hospital in Kirkwall being the main site. Approximately 750 staff work for NHS Orkney on clinical and non-clinical roles, with others employed as 'bank' or temporary staff.
