ABOUT BBC RADIO ORKNEY

BBC Radio Orkney is a community radio station which started broadcasting in 1978. Orkney and Shetland are fairly unique in the UK in being served by their own local BBC programmes. The media has changed greatly over the last 45 years, and as well as radio programmes they now also create material for TV, social media and the BBC's online services which means their content is used right across the BBC's services.

Locally, they employ six people, including a trainee. They also have people working on a casual freelance basis. BBC Radio Orkney are based on Castle Street, Kirkwall while the BBC has offices around the world.

Staff at BBC Radio Orkney are **multi-media journalist** working with smartphones as well as broadcast quality TV equpment and editing systems.
