TRAINEE OPPORTUNITY

Soulisquoy Printmakers are one of three partners across Scotland who are taking part in *ART evolution*, an exciting new collaborative and responsive programme supporting young people aged 14- 25, freelance artists, creative educators and visual arts organisations/galleries as they emerge from the COVID-19 pandemic.

ART evolution is supported by Creative Scotland and managed by Engage Scotland and is providing funds to Soulisquoy to facilitate a group of interested young people to commission a local artist/printmaker to collaborate with them and co-produce a project of their own design.

As part of the project we are looking to recruit a young person 16-25 years to take part in a short training programme and be closely involved in the running of the project, its development and delivery.

The time commitment for the traineeship will mostly be at weekends and evenings and could suit someone who is still at school, at college or already working. It will be a chance to learn a bit about working in the arts sector, about project management, printmaking and be a very unique experience to add to a young person's CV.

Traineeship Bursary: The successful recipient will receive a £2000 bursary to participate in the programme.

Time Commitment: approximately equivalent to two evenings a week from mid to late October to mid-January, Saturday 6 November and the following weekends Saturdays & Sundays 20&21, 27&28 November, 4&5, 11&12 December.

Traineeship Programme: The programme will be tailored to suit the needs of the successful individual and will provide training in the following transferable skills: communications, project management, marketing, making applications, and CV development. In addition, specific training for this project will include, practical workshop planning, delivery, facilitation, evaluation and monitoring, as well as a range of printmaking techniques and processes.

- Advertising and recruiting the artist/printmakers
