

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE COURSES

The University of the Highlands and Islands Archaeology Institute offers both single honours degrees in Archaeology (BA Hons) and Archaeological Science (BSc Hons), along with a range of joint degrees where you can combine Archaeology with subjects such as History, Environmental Studies, Criminology, Literature and Sociology.

WANT TO TAKE YOUR STUDIES FURTHER?

The University of the Highlands and Islands Archaeology Institute offers taught masters postgraduate opportunities to complete research through MLitt Archaeological Studies, MSc Archaeological Practice, and MLitt History and Archaeology of the Highlands and Islands.

These courses are designed for students who have already obtained a 2:2 Honours degree or above in archaeology or a relevant subject or equivalent academic or professional qualifications. However, candidates who possess experience in archaeology or a related field may also be able to apply. If in doubt then just get in touch with us.

We also offer research opportunities through our postgraduate research degrees: PhD, MPhil and MRes provision for students who have obtained a 2:1 Honours and/or a taught Masters degree.

NOT SURE ABOUT A UNIVERSITY DEGREE?

At Orkney College, in addition to our undergraduate and postgraduate degree programmes in archaeology, the University of the Highlands and Islands Archaeology Institute offers a NVQ in Archaeological Practice and Access to degree level study modules.
